Instructions

- 1) Only programmatic and language requests will be considered. Earmark requests, as defined by clause 9(e) of Rule XXI of the Rules of the House, will **not** be considered.
 - a. *For the purpose of this clause, the term “congressional earmark” means a provision or report language included primarily at the request of a Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, or Senator providing, authorizing or recommending a specific amount of discretionary budget authority, credit authority, or other spending authority for a contract, loan, loan guarantee, grant, loan authority, or other expenditure with or to an entity, or targeted to a specific State, locality or Congressional district, other than through a statutory or administrative formula driven or competitive award process.*
- 2) Requests must be submitted via e-mail to the appropriate staff and by the deadlines listed in the table below.
- 3) All questions on the form must be completed.
- 4) One submission per form.
- 5) Include a letter on your entity’s official letterhead asking for the request.
- 6) If applicable, include a draft letter to the relevant Appropriations Subcommittee.
- 7) Please note that all submitted forms are subject to public disclosure.
